

Residential Teaching Monastics at the Buddhaloka Centre Malvern

The BSV committee is the sole decision-maker with regards to the success of the application.

The following conditions apply:

- As English is the teaching medium a very good knowledge of English is required
- The approval of the BSV spiritual adviser, Ajahn Brahm
- The holding of Australian Residency or a visa suitable for teaching
- Holding of comprehensive health insurance cover

Short-term non-teaching applicants may be accepted for a maximum of one week's stay and should apply in the same way as above.
